Then select five courses that will inform or increase your knowledge about your chosen topic.

**Courses:** For scheduling flexibility it is best to include additional courses. Be mindful of four things:

- 1. Within the concentration and outside of PACS, no more than 2 courses may be taken from the same department. All courses selected for the concentration must be reviewed and approved by the program.
- Students must submit the Self-Designed Concentration Approval Form with at least 5 courses of their choosing, 2 of which must be PACS courses. They will also submit a 1-2 page statement demonstrating articulation and coherence among the courses. Please note that any courses listed on the Concentration Approval Form must be addressed in the statement.
- 3. Concentration courses may not be double-counted towards another requirement within the major.
- 4. Any changes in either the Concentration topic or coursework listed on this form must be re-approved by the IAS Faculty Committee.
